Boynton Beach Garden Club Committees

ART IN BLOOM Coordinates the annual show in which members arrange flowers to interpret artwork supplied by local elementary school students. Awards given in different categories.

FUNDRAISING Plans and organizes fundraising project(s) to fund donations to community organizations and scholarships to children summer programs such as Camp Wekiva.

AWARDS Recognizes membership or committee achievements following the goals and objectives of the FFGC Awards.

HORTICULTURE Provides a brief educational presentation at each monthly meeting.

BUTTERFLY CERTIFICATION Tours gardens of members requesting certification and awards certification when approved by state chairman. Provides education on butterfly plants at monthly meetings.

BYLAWS Meets as needed to make changes or corrections.

HOSPITALITY Coordinates refreshments at meetings and events.

WEBSITE Maintains accuracy and updates information as needed on the website. Helps the webmaster with site functions.

PENNY PINES Collects donations for the replanting replacement of trees indigenous to a particular damaged area. The jar for donations is passed at monthly meetings.

BLUE STAR MARKER Organizes a ceremony held at Blue Star Marker on Veterans' Day. These markers across the highways of the U.S. pay tribute to those who served in the armed forces.

RAFFLES Organizes monthly meeting fundraiser raffle, generally raffling donated plants.

RUSTIC RETREAT Coordinates November visit and other visits during the year in support of the Veterans Retirement Home.

TRIPS/LUNCHEONS Coordinates bus trips, carpools for members; plans the summer luncheons.

BUTTERFLY GARDEN Maintains the garden located by the Schoolhouse Children's Museum, Ocean Ave, Boynton Beach.

COMMUNITY GARDEN Maintains the garden on N.Seacrest and NW 5th Ave in Boynton Beach.

YOUTH GARDENERS Works with and helps to educate elementary age children about Florida gardening at local elementary school.

MEMORIAL GARDEN Maintains the garden at Highpoint West, located at our meeting site.

YEARBOOK Updates new yearbook and makes changes as needed.

Wekiva/SEEK Identifies possible applicants for either camp.

SUNSHINE Sends birthday and get well cards and phone calls as needed.

PUBLICITY Creates public awareness of our club and activities.
